

FROM RESCUED TO SEARCH AND RESCUE

At 30 years old, I did not know I needed to be rescued. But God, who I wanted to please, was drawing me to Himself. He allowed me to get into a position that made me realize I needed something more. At the time, I just did not know what it was.

As a young wife and mother of three under five years old, moving every year or two, I was busy trying to keep up with it all. My husband traveled in his job and I was often alone and kept needing to make new friends.

My rescue was gradual and took several faithful Stonecroft volunteers to get me to the place of starting a new life knowing Jesus as my savior.

Ever since then Jesus has been at my side to guide, comfort, discipline, and love me. He has brought my husband and I through some difficult times in our marriage and therefore, I have been able to understand and help other women in those circumstances.

The gift I received when I accepted Jesus was a zeal to reach others who do not know Him- and that zeal has never left me for one day. Over the years, living in many places, I have had the privilege of guiding (part of the rescue) hundreds of women and bringing them to Jesus through the Stonecroft small groups.

In our culture today, many are raised not knowing anything about God and they, unknowingly, are searching for Him.

If you are part of a Stonecroft outreach group or a Stonecroft small group, you have the opportunity to be trained in a search and rescue mission to reach those who are looking for Jesus who will give them the answers to life.

Jesus says, "I am the way, the truth, and the life and no man comes to the father except through me." Do you really believe that?

We are activated by what we really believe.

That is what I was taught many years ago by the author of the studies and I am activated every day to search for and find those who are waiting to be rescued.

As you pray and ask Him, our Father may bring someone right in front of you. He will let you know if He wants you to befriend that person so you can rescue them. Remember, you can only rescue someone who our Father is drawing to Himself so it is important to ask Him, "Who?", then stay close to Jesus, and watch and wait.

It is very important to make sure you leave time in your schedule and are available as you may have an opportunity to meet with someone who is in trouble and calling for help. You do not want to make them wait! When someone is out in the water and you throw them a lifesaver and they grab on to it, you do not holler out to them and say, "a Bible study is starting in three weeks. I will be out to get you then!" So that person has to bob around in the water until you are ready to pull them in with the life saver?? No way!!! You pull them in immediately. You rescue them and then begin a Bible study right away. You love and disciple them with a "Why Believe?" Bible study. You are ready and willing and waiting for them. They will learn who God is, how we they can know the Bible is valid, who this Jesus is, and why Christianity is a relationship and not a religion.

We do have a choice in how we spend our days, and there are a lot of activities to fill up our time, but few of the results last for eternity. Your investment of time in searching and rescuing those headed for an eternity without God has eternal benefits for them.....and you. How blessed we are to know the God who loves us enough to ask us to be part of bringing people to live with Him forever. All praise and glory to Him!
